The Week Ahead



Every May we have a very important process here at Christ the King Catholic Community: **THE SELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS FOR OUR PASTORAL COUNCIL.**

Pastoral Councils began after the sweeping changes of the Second Vatican Council. A major thrust of the Council was the invitation for more of the laity to participate more actively in the life of their local parishes. This is seen in many aspects of parish life today: most noticeably in liturgy with so many lay men and women ministering as greeters, lectors, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, musicians, coordinators, altar setters, bread bakers and more. Also, today most parish staffs are predominantly laity in positions that in the past were held only by priests, religious brothers or sisters; e.g., directors of faith formation, liturgists, youth ministers, music directors etc.

Likewise, in the governance of the parish, it is highly recommended (in some U.S. dioceses mandated!) that each parish has as pastoral council. Such councils are always advisory, that is, the membership advises the pastor and his staff about the administration, staffing, finances and programs of the parish. *I find our CTK Council invaluable both as an advisory board to me and also as a sounding board to whom I can float new ideas and get sound feedback and support.*

Our council has 15 members: 12 “selected” and 3 appointed by me. Each year, one third of the membership leaves the council and is replaced by 5 new members. We have traditionally scheduled this “Selection Process” during the month of May. With Easter being so late this year — the last Sunday of April — we seem to have gotten a little later start than usual. So, I beg your kind attention and participation in the process.

I have purposefully used the words “select” and “selection” — because, this is NOT an election: no campaigning, no slogans, no ballots. Rather, the process is done by way of conversation, dialogue, discussion and consensus at two very important meetings: the first meeting is Wednesday, May 18, and the second is Wednesday, May 25: each beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Center. Please mark your calendars and try to attend both; if you can only make one that’s okay. At the first May 18th meeting, those who have been nominated are informed of the procedures for the next meeting; at the second May 25th meeting, the selection process is conducted with all parishioners who are in attendance. Nominees must be registered parishioners of Christ the King — 18 years old or older. That’s it! You may nominate yourself or others by filling out the Nomination Form (available at the Welcome Desk) or by coming to the May 18th meeting. Nominations must be in by that date.

Religious Education Grades 1-5 First Communion

Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-F 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:30 or 6:00 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.
