## The Week Ahead



There's a number of events happening in the Diocese that are of major importance; I hope that you are able to attend some of these up-coming celebrations. Here they are:

**The Tenth Anniversary of Bishop Joseph A. Pepe's Ordination to the Episcopate and Installation as the Second Bishop of the Diocese of Las Vegas. This will take place on Tuesday, May 31, at 5:30 p.m. at the Guardian Angel Cathedral (Cathedral Way and Las Vegas Boulevard South — just to the north of the Encore Hotel/Casino).**

**The Ordination of 19 men to the Permanent Diaconate. I am the Director of Diaconate Formation and I couldn't be more proud or more excited at this occasion! These men have been in the formation program for five years and are filled with excitement at their ordination. This will be the 'first-ever' such ordination for our diocese. Although we have deacons serving in many of our parishes, these deacons have all been ordained in other dioceses in the country and subsequently moved to Las Vegas. It will be a very special day. The Ordination Mass will be celebrated at the Shrine of the Most Holy Redeemer (E. Reno Ave and Las Vegas Boulevard South — at the far south end of the Strip, across from Mandalay Bay) at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, June 3.**

**Finally, there is my own celebration: my 40th Anniversary of Ordination. It's difficult to believe that 40 years have gone by. I look forward to celebrating this day with family, friends, fellow clergy, but most of all with the two parishes that are so dear to me: Christ the King and Holy Spirit. This celebration takes place at Christ the King with a Mass beginning at 6:00 p.m. to be followed by a reception in the parish courtyard. Although June 19 is the actual anniversary date, the celebration is on Friday, June 17. Please RSVP as noted on the front of the bulletin. Thanks.**

## CTK "FOOD FOR THE SPIRIT" COOKBOOK ON SALE TODAY

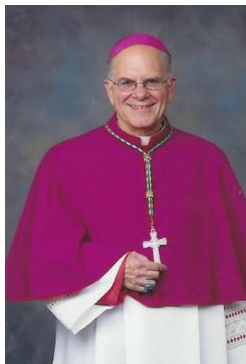

## Religious Education Grades 1-5 First Communion Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-F 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

### **When are classes held?**

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:30 or 6:00 pm

### **Fees:**

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

**\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.**

### **SACRAMENTS**

*(1st Communion, Baptism)*

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

**Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.**
