



Religious Education Grades 1-5 First Communion Baptism of older children How do I enroll my child?

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-F 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered. REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:30 or 6:00 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)
REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
