The Week Ahead



Well, what do you know? I have given you the wrong information as to the spelling of the acronym for **Christ Renews His Parish**. I have been writing it as CHRP, thinking that the "CH" came from the first two letters of "Christ", "R" from "Renews" and "P" from "Parish" – skipping the small word "his" and thus in order of those letters the spoken nickname "**Chirp**" – adding the "i" to make a spoken word possible. But I have been wrong!! The real acronym is "**CRHP**", that is the "R" BEFORE the "H", and then the acronym is formed from the first letter of EACH word of "**Christ Renews His Parish**". That makes sense – until you try to form the spoken nickname: then you have to reverse the letters and put "h" before the "r", add the "i" in between those two letters, put "C" in front and "p" in back and then you get "**Chirp**". That's more trivia about "**CRHP**" then you'll really ever need to know. But, since **CRHP** is copyrighted, we'd better use all the correct words, abbreviations, acronyms and nicknames!

Now for some more facts about **CRHP**: as of June 30, 2010 (a year ago and thus the numbers are certainly larger now!), **CRHP** was active in 4 countries besides the United States; in the U.S., 1168 parishes have a **CRHP** program; it is found in 89 U.S. (arch)dioceses and 34 states! There are also expressions of **CRHP** in 9 other Christian denominations and is used in the U.S. Military and even in U.S. prisons! Christ the King will be the first in Nevada; so we will be making history as we add our own diocese (Las Vegas) to the statistics as well as the state of Nevada – plus one more parish.

As of today (July 27, 2011), 34 women have signed up for the inaugural weekend of September 17/18. That means that we are full! Wow! What a great response! Thanks to all. More info later.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:30 or 6:00 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:

- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.
