LA PRESENCIA DE DIOS

Después del milagro en que Jesús camina sobre el agua, los discípulos exclaman:

Lord, command me to come to you on the water

After the miracle of Jesus walking on water, the disciples exclaimed, "Truly, you are the Son of God" (Matthew 14:33). Most Christians will probably never experience such a dramatic miracle. Like Elijah, we await the manifestation of God in other moments. Perhaps the biggest challenge for the believer is to be constantly attuned to the possible presence of God in the everyday events of life. This is a stance that takes some people years to develop. Others seem to find the Lord easily in the simple things. As the week unfolds, let us look for the presence of God in the little things around us. The Week Ahead



It is so often the case that the best way to get someone to volunteer or help you out or join some group is the personal invitation! A sarcasm often heard is that *"If you want to keep something a secret, put it in the Church bulletin!"* So, I need your help to find some people; in fact, the people I want to find probably don't even get a Church bulletin — if they were to read it anyway! These people are your relatives, in-laws, friends, neighbors and co-workers.

I'm sure that in some of your conversations with such persons the topic of religion comes up. Do any of them show an interest in the Catholic faith? Are any of them searching for a spiritual home? Such individuals could fall into three groups: 1) persons who have NO religious background or affiliation whatsoever; 2) persons who belong to a non-Christian religion but are unsatisfied in their faith or curious about Christianity; e.g., those who are Jewish, Moslem, Hindu, etc. or 3) those who are already Christian (e.g., Lutheran, Baptist, Mormon etc.) but likewise are unsatisfied with their church and/or are wondering about Catholicism.

Or in your talking with others, you may know some who used to be Catholic? Have any of them drifted away from the Catholic faith? Why? Perhaps they were hurt by someone or some teaching of the Catholic faith and left in anger. Or maybe they are not married in the Catholic Church and have been told **WRONGLY** that they are no longer members!

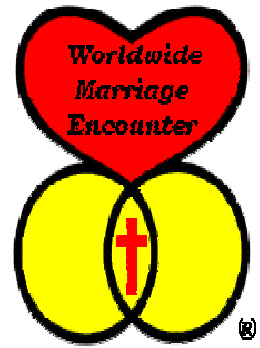
Want to become better acquainted with Christ?

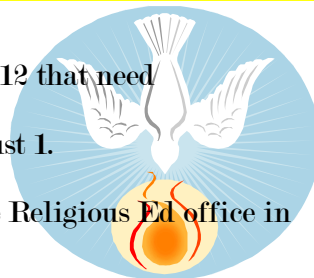

Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-Th 8:00 am - 4:00 pm and Friday 8:00am to 12pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:00 or 5:45 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.
