TRUST

Keys hold great significance for those who carry them. They represent the trust and authority of the owner when given to another person. We may give our house key to a trusted friend to take care of our matters while we are away. We may give keys to someone responsible for maintaining or working in a particular building. Keys to vehicles are given to people who have proven themselves responsible drivers. The readings today focus on this kind of trust—the trust that conveys authority and responsibility. In the first reading, the symbol is specifically that of a key; but the second reading and the Gospel also speak of trust and leadership as they refer to the earthly church that Jesus established.

The Week Ahead



First of all, thanks and congratulations to all those who worked on and attended the first-ever (hopefully “annual”) “Back to School” Fashion Show at Christ the King. To be honest, I was skeptical about the popularity of such an event: in fact, I, myself, had never been to any “fashion show” ever before: this was my “first”! And,

I enjoyed it thoroughly — as did many others: as we almost filled up the Community Center. The day was wonderful: a delicious brunch, door prizes, raffles and a 50/50 jackpot, but most of all an amazing Fashion Show: the “models” were all ages — from 4-year-olds to ‘20-somethings’! All were well-trained, full of poise and just awesome! As soon as we get next year’s date, I’ll publish it so you can put it in your social calendars.

Another recent exciting happening at Christ the King: the visit of Father Manny’s Bishop from the Philippines to CTK to conduct the annual “required” mission appeal. We had forgotten to publish it ahead of time; this is usually done so that you can be prepared to bring some extra money for that special collection. Honestly, I always worry about this Mission Collection (which is a Diocesan requirement) as it inevitably ‘cuts into’ the regular parish collection. The last few years I have been more worried because of the ‘dip’ in our weekend collection amounts; and, of course, during the summer months, collections are lower than usual.

So, I was expecting a rather disappointing regular collection that weekend of the Philippine Mission Appeal. I even reminded Fr. Manny to remind all of you not to neglect the regular collection. Wow!! Was I ever pleasantly surprised! On that Saturday/Sunday, August 9/10, the Mission Collection was \$14,249.50 and the regular collection was \$19,818.00. When you add the \$3,076.00 that came in through “E-tithing,” the full weekend collection was \$22,894.00 — which is slightly over our necessary projected weekly income of \$22,785.00.

So, I have to conclude that if you had \$34,067.50 in “your pockets” that weekend, I could challenge you to give just a little bit more each weekend! Someone questioned my “talking/writing” about money so much lately. That’s the least favorite subject for me! But, we are in the worst recession of my lifetime. I have been successful in keeping all full-time personnel at CTK on the payroll (though without raises or bonuses for three years) and I want to continue to do, rather than add them to the “unemployment” list. They, in turn, continue to provide for all of our wonderful ministries — that are so much a “hallmark” of CTK. So please consider adding just a little bit more EACH week. Your sacrifice will go a long way.

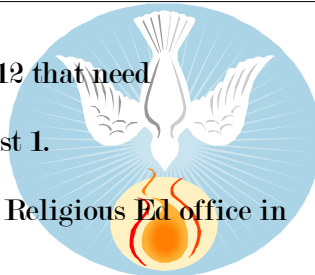

We require that you worship with us for at least six weeks before you call to register for the Alpha/Baptism sessions. No Baptisms may be scheduled until sessions and requirements are completed.

Pre-registration is required for Alpha/Baptism sessions.

Religious Education Grades 1-5 First Communion

Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-Th 8:00 am - 4:00 pm and Friday 8:00am to 12pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:00 or 5:45 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.
