#### THE CROSS OF JESUS

The perception of a cross changed dramatically after Jesus' crucifixion. Before that event, death on a cross was not only horrible, it was degrading. It was a penalty reserved only for the most wretched of criminals. The word "glory" would not have found its way into the same sentence containing the word "cross." But all that changed with Jesus. Over time, believers began to venerate and honor the cross. They painted, sculpted, and carved images of it. Many lost their own lives for their association with it. Today our reverence for and relationship with the cross recalls little of the contempt originally associated with it. As it has been through the ages, it is our perception of the cross that determines how we follow Jesus.

Today begins the last 'full' week of summer: next weekend is the final "fling" of summer 2011—Labor Day weekend! So, enjoy the week and the three-day holiday coming up!

Most parishes operate on a "school-year" mentality or calendar; that is, many programs slow down during the summer months and start

again in September — in full force. So, too, here at Christ the King.

I ask you then to look at ALL the pages in this bulletin and see what's happening at the parish and in what programs you need to register. Each year, our parish get's busier . . . and so do your lives!

Although most schools are now in full session (in "my day" we NEVER started school until AFTER Labor Day!!!), our religious education programs usually wait a few weeks until after the kids are back in school and adjusted to "school days" (or "daze"?) again. But, we don't want to start so late that your kids get so involved in school and extracurricular activities that religious education classes or sessions just don't fit into their busy schedule.

I know it can be difficult for the parents to impress upon their children and teenagers (especially!) the importance of being involved in their Catholic parish and the programs that are specifically designed for young people; but, I strongly believe that it's part of your parental responsibility to get the kids going to Mass and religious education classes on a regular basis.

Now, I fully realize how busy some families are: often both parents working, kids in different schools (e.g., elementary, middle and/or high school) plus all the other activities that so many of our kids find fun and important: soccer, football, baseball, track, basketball, swimming, cheerleading, speech and debate, scouting, music, dance, homework, household chores, part-time (or even full-time!) jobs, dating, parties, trips — whew! I'm exhausted already!

Having written all that, I hope that Catholic worship, formation, education and social life would be part of your lives and that of your children. You are really the most influential teachers your children have; and that influence can be negative or positive! Your good example is the best lesson of all: so, let's get the WHOLE family going to Mass and participating in parish life — especially religious formation for the children and teenagers.

## Religious Education Grades 1-5 First Communion Baptism of older children How do I enroll my child?

Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1 -5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-Th 8:00 am - 4:00 pm and Friday 8:00am to 12pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

#### When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:00 or 5:45 pm

#### Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
- First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
- Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.

\$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.

#### **SACRAMENTS**

# (1st Communion, Baptism) REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

### Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.
