## The Week Ahead



The first-ever Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) weekend has been held at Christ the King and was a powerful experience for those CTK participants: 28 women. As I observed and spent some time with the CRHP team (13 women from Toledo, Ohio) and our own parish participants, I knew that great things were happening: a deepening of faith, a greater appreciation of the Bible, the Mass, the Sacraments and prayer; in

addition, many new friendships were formed and an renewed desire to be more active at CTK. This is exactly what I hoped for and prayed for.

Now, it's time for the MEN'S CRHP weekend. It is scheduled for October 29/30 — a Saturday/Sunday. Yes, I know that it is a 3-day weekend for us in Nevada: Friday, October 28 is a state holiday (Nevada Admission Day); schools observe this holiday and a few other businesses. My feeling is that not too many families actually leave town for the weekend. But, we are at the 'mercy' of the schedules of those who are traveling to Las Vegas to be the Men's Team: — again a group from Toledo, Ohio (10 men in all), who are taking off the weekend and paying their own round trip air fares to Las Vegas (from Detroit — closest airport to Toledo). So, this first Men's CRHP dates are set: Saturday/Sunday, October 29/30. Times are from 8:00 a.m. check-in on Saturday, October 28, through completion on Sunday, October 30, at about 4:00 p.m.

The maximum number of participants is 30 — first come/first serve! Participants must be CTK parishioners or at least live within the boundaries of CTK. The program is "Christ Renews His PARISH" (in this case, CTK) — not "Christ Renews Las Vegas". It is a parish-based program and requires that all participants are, in fact, a part of CTK. We will need all the same things we needed for the Women's CRHP: **1) 30-hour Adoration over the entire course of the weekend; a sign-up list will be available soon. 2) Prayer letters from other parishioners to the men on the weekend: the Prayer Box will be out in the Gathering Space in a few weeks. 3) the borrowing of 10 sleeping bags so the Toledo team doesn't have to pack sleeping bags on the plane! If you lent a sleeping bag for this last weekend, you may pick it up at the Office; or if you are able to keep it here at CTK until the end of October to be used by one of the men, you can pick it up in early November. 4) pies, cakes, cookies and brownies for weekend desserts: these should be delivered by Friday, October 28; I think we need a sign up list for this, too, as this had the weakest participation last weekend! and 5) monetary donations to off-set the cost of the weekend: actually, all the initial expenses were met by some very generous people; in fact, there is still money in the account for the next CRHP; however, if you want to donate, it will go for this and future CRHP weekends — like those to be scheduled for women and men in the Spring of 2012.**

**BUT FIRST: we need MEN. Please call Deacon Jacob to reserve your spot. The parish phone number is 871-1904. Remember, it's first come/first serve. So, sign up ASAP. The Women's CRHP filled up in just a few weeks after the initial announcement in this column. I hope that there is a similar desire in the men of the parish to experience such a renewal!**

# LITURGY CORNER

## THE NEW ROMAN MISSAL

**Old:** *"The Lord be with you...And also with you..."*

**New:** *"The Lord be with you...And with your spirit..."*

In Fr. Bill's "Cheers" column last week he made reference to one of the most common greetings and responses used during the liturgy: *"The Lord be with you... And also with you."* On the first Sunday of Advent 2011 the revised translated response will be: *"And with your spirit."* This rendering is more faithful to the original Latin text and has a much richer spiritual meaning for us.

Both the greeting and response are based on words and phrases from the old and new testaments of the bible. Our Jewish and Christian ancestors used the words *"The Lord be with you"* in greeting one another. (Ruth 2:4; 2 Chronicles 15:2). So too when the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary he said, *"The Lord be with you."* (Luke 1:28). In many of St. Paul's letters he addresses the various communities in words such as: *"The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit."* (2 Tim. 4:22; Gal. 6:18; Phil. 4:23).

From the first word to the last word of the mass, this greeting and our response are used several times and are part of a *prayer* experience that extends beyond a friendly greeting to one another on the street. We acknowledge the presence of the Lord in a special way *within* the priest as Presider at the liturgy. We are reminded that Jesus Christ is present, that the time we will share together is holy.

We acknowledge the Holy Spirit inside *each* of us. Through this acknowledgement the grace of God is at work. If there are divisions among us, the gap or divide is made that much smaller. If we are in spiritual distress or need, the support of the community is very much present. If we are full of joy and peace that too is given to the community, through the Holy Spirit we proclaim as being present within each of us.

This recognition and proclamation of the Holy Spirit within each of us bears with it the responsibility to be present to one another, not only during the liturgy but beyond the bounds of the mass, into our very lives. So, the next time you're at mass you just might want to think about the words you'll be saying, praying and committing yourself to.

#### REQUIREMENTS:
