GOD IS IN CHARGE

“Who do you think you are?!” today’s readings demand. We are brought up short, put in our place, given a dose of reality. Who is God? Who is in charge? Who is the greatest?

We begin with a passage from the prophet Malachi, one of the latest prophets, who wrote after the Jews returned from Babylon. Calling the people to task in God’s name, he condemns the divisions and false teachings that have arisen, reminding them that all were created by the one God. Paul tells the Thessalonians the same thing, but in a positive way—praising them for remembering that it is God who is at work within them.

Finally, the Gospel presents Jesus speaking out against hypocrisy and vainglory. “You have but one teacher . . . you have but one Father” (Matthew 23:8, 9). We are firmly put in our place. God is in charge.

The Week Ahead



Fall Triduum"!? "Triduum" means "3 Days" and refers to the three days preceding Easter — Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. But, I have always been fascinated by what I call the "Fall Triduum" of October 31, November 1 and November 2. There's a lot of confusion and misinformation about these three days; so let me give a little teaching:

The "CENTRAL" feast of these three days is November 1 — **ALL SAINTS' DAY**. On this day, we remember **all** persons who are in heaven: not only those who have been officially recognized by the church through the process of canonization, but also all those who have died and are with God forever. **This day is a holy day of obligation** and here, at Christ the King, we have two Masses scheduled: 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

As many of our feasts have an evening anticipation (such as Christmas Eve and Easter Vigil), All Saints or as called in some places **ALL HALLOWS** (meaning "holy" or "saintly" as in "**hallowed be thy name**") is anticipated on the day before with "**Hallows Evening**" — eventually shortened to **HALLOWEEN**: October 31. One explanation of costumes is the practice of dressing up as saints. There are pagan origins to this day as well: since the dark days of winter were approaching, it was thought that the dead re-appeared and walked around the streets. These spirits could be met in one of two ways: 1) **scaring them away** by wearing masks or putting out grotesque images such as carved pumpkins; or 2) **appeasing them** with 'soul cakes' or sweets; if one did not give them such treats, the spirit could send evil upon the person. Thus, we have the background of wearing 'spooky' costumes and 'trick-or-treating'!

The third day of this "Triduum" is **ALL SOULS DAY** which is November 2 on which day we remember all those who have died among our family members, relatives and friends — especially in the last year. **THIS IS NOT A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION!** However, many like to attend Mass or a Service in memory of their deceased loved ones. We have a Mass at 8:00 a.m. and an Evening Prayer Service (bi-lingual: English/Spanish) at 7:00 p.m.

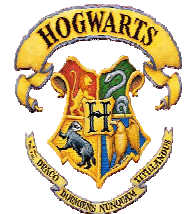
