EXPECTING THE UNEXPECTED

If it ever crossed your mind that Jesus was somewhat lacking in a sense of humor, today's Gospel should belie any such notion. Jesus' story of the five wise and five foolish bridesmaids is downright hilarious. The circumstances of the story were surely familiar to Jesus' listeners, just as they are—if we think about it—to us. Weddings never, *never* start on time. There's always a delay. Buttons pop off at the last minute. Flowers wilt. Cars full of wedding guests get caught in traffic. Soloists contract laryngitis. Brides or grooms or priests show up late! So the only reasonable way to approach a wedding is with a sense of humor, to realize that something probably will go awry, and, when that happens, to smile about it.

Jesus tells this funny story to encourage us to be watchful, yes; to be ready, yes. But he doesn't tell it to make us dour and somber. The heavy-hearted tremble, waver, lose sight of their place and purpose, and fall asleep. The lighthearted know that the unexpected will happen—is bound to happen—so they are awake in their place and ready in their purpose when it comes.

The Week Ahead



As I write this CHEERS! column, it is two days before our Annual Auction and Raffle. This is our biggest fund-raiser of the year and I am hoping that it will have been very successful and fun! I'll report on the final figures in future bulletins.

Speaking of figures, if you read the financial reports in this bulletin, you will note that we are running about \$40,000 behind in anticipated income. This budget is based on last year's income and I was hoping that we would keep at that same level this year. We would like to average about \$22,000 a weekend; so, we are down by about two weekends of revenue. In an upcoming report, I will try to give you a better picture of our finances: are our other sources of income coming in as budgeted? Higher? Lower? Are our expenses higher or lower than anticipated? This report will give us a more realistic view of our financial health here at CTK. In the meantime, I hope that you will continue to be generous in your financial support of the parish, Thanks so much!

As you read this bulletin, Thanksgiving is only 18 days away: hard to believe! I would really like all to participate in our Thanksgiving Food Drive. So, on the Saturday/Sunday before Thanksgiving (November 19/20 — feast of Christ the King!), please bring in Thanksgiving Dinner food items (that don't require refrigeration!). That weekend is the deadline since the baskets are put together on Monday, November 21.

Our celebration of Thanksgiving will be at a special Mass on Thanksgiving Day at 9:30 a.m. This is a wonderful way to begin the holiday. Plan to be there!

Friday of this week is a national holiday, Veterans' Day: our office will be closed.

And, in less than three weeks, Advent will begin. I'll detail many of the Advent/Christmas activities in the upcoming bulletins. But, remember, with the beginning of Advent, all the new Mass texts are mandatory!

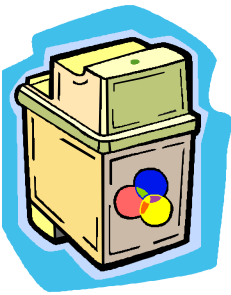
