# LITURGY CORNER

## THE NEW ROMAN MISSAL TRANSLATION BEGINS THIS SUNDAY

As the psalmist says: "This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad in it." (Ps. 118)

Yes, this is truly the day the Lord has made as today marks a new beginning for all the English speaking world in regards to the celebration of the mass. This is the day when the new translation of the words we use, both for the presider and congregation, will be different.

You will notice some of the changes are minor and some more major. All of us will no doubt stumble and have to use our worship aid for several weeks or perhaps months, until we learn the revised texts, but be assured that just as each of us learned the responses and prayers before, we will learn them again. They will become second nature to us as the liturgy will hopefully become a source of new life and a renewed spiritual experience for us.

As we've addressed prior in this column, the following greeting and response during the liturgy will be changed:

Old: "The Lord be with you....And also with you..."

New: "The Lord be with you...And with your spirit..."

Because this is used frequently throughout the mass, we will, for the Advent and Christmas seasons, be presenting the phrase to you in a *simple chant* form that is very easy to follow. The presider will simply chant the phrase and we will respond in that same chant back to him. By doing this hopefully it will make us stop and think about what we're responding, not just being on "automatic pilot". So too when we add chant to the liturgy it adds a whole different dimension to the celebration.

May we embrace these changes and come to the Lord with opened hearts as we welcome the gift before us!

### Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

**Elementary Registration for 2011/12 year Grades 1-5 will begin July 5 in the Religious Ed Office M-Th 8:00 am - 4:00 pm and Friday 8:00am to 12pm. A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.**

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

#### **When are classes held?**

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:00 or 5:45 pm

#### **Fees:**

- Religious Education Classes \$75.00 per child.
  - First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
  - Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.
- \$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.**

#### **SACRAMENTS**

*(1st Communion, Baptism)*

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.
