## The Week Ahead



Happy New Year! This Sunday, November 27, is the first day of the new 'liturgical' year! There are some special aspects of this new year — more so than usual:

1) We are beginning the use of the **NEW ROMAN MISSAL** which has been over 10 years in the making! It will take us some time to adjust to the new words in our Mass texts. We have been learning about some of the responses for the assembly, but the presider/priest has a lot more to re-learn. So be patient with the priests as they might be slower than usual (with new words and phrases) or unintentionally saying the 'old words.' In time, my hope is not only that we will soon become familiar with the revised Mass texts, but more importantly that we will develop a greater love for the Mass itself.

2) This year, Advent is the longest it can be: a full four weeks or 28 days — making November 27 the earliest date for the First Sunday of Advent. The shortest? 22 days. This occurs when the First Sunday of Advent is December 3: making the Fourth Sunday of Advent December 24 and Christmas Day — the very next day on Monday, December 25. This will happen in 2017.

3) There are only three regular Sundays in December: the last one being Christmas Day itself! When this happens, we are short one Sunday for our collections. Normally, we plan 51 Sundays a year for weekend contributions, plus Easter (always a Sunday — making it the 52nd Sunday) and Christmas — which two feasts also bring in the largest contributions! However, this year with Christmas on a Sunday, there are only 50 Sundays of regular collections plus the two major feasts of Christmas and Easter — both this year on a Sunday. So, if you contribute on a weekly basis, you'll only be giving three regular Sunday contributions plus Christmas. I ask you then, for our budget's sake, to double up on one of the December Sundays to make up for the lost Sunday or make a larger than usual Christmas donation. Thanks so much!

**Advent is my favorite season of the year: the expectation of Christmas, the chilly weather, the gatherings of family and friends, the holiday movies and music, the decorations in stores and homes, the general feeling of "peace and good will." Happy Advent!**

# LITURGY CORNER

## ADVENT and the NEW ROMAN MISSAL

We made it through the first week-end of the Advent season and the first usage of the New Roman Missal translation. How did you do? How did the community do at the liturgy you attended? You no doubt experienced many different feelings throughout the mass, not only because of the changes in the words but because it is a new liturgical season as well. The environment was different, the prayers were different, the whole feeling was different. Different is neither good nor bad, just "different."

Be gentle with yourself and the community as we go about the next several months learning, adapting and "*praying*" with new words. Let yourself be brought into the "*spirit*" of both Advent and the liturgy itself. Don't get bogged down in what might be your personal likes of the way things "used" to be.

For a time we will be relying upon having our songbooks in our hands to guide us with the changed prayers and responses. Just remember, eventually we won't need the reminder of the proper words and the prayers will be true "prayers" that come from our hearts.

This is a time of grace being offered us, a time to further study and expand our interest in the liturgy as well as an invitation from the Holy Spirit to renew our prayer experience.
