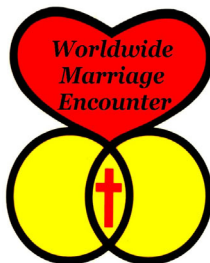

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

Every rectory office has received a panicked phone call from a person who has been invited to serve as a godparent, or from someone newly engaged, who suddenly “needs to get confirmed.” While the lack of confirmation is not an obstacle for marriage, it is for godparenting. Many are surprised that the Church seems to be looking for a kind of sacramental “seal” on one’s baptism before the door opens fully to this ministry. Yet if you think about it, would you want someone to guide you to a place that he or she had not yet been? A godparent has to be someone who has “been there” and knows the way. Although signet rings and wax seals have passed from use, our society depends on “seals of approval” ranging from certificates of quality to the familiar safety seals on medicines and foods. While Eucharist is the “seal” of the sacrament of baptism, there is a sense in which one’s Christian initiation is also incomplete without confirmation. Have you been confirmed? Perhaps it’s time to inquire now, before you have to make that dreaded phone call!

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El 19 de abril en Uruguay se conmemora a la Virgen del Verdún, que está colocada sobre una columna de seis metros en uno de los cerros que rodean la ciudad de Minas. Esta imagen fue puesta allí por el párroco don José De Luca en 1900. Su intención era dedicar esta imagen en recuerdo del siglo diecinueve y recibir así el siglo veinte, dedicándolo a María Inmaculada en honor de Cristo Redentor. En el 2007 la peregrinación a la Virgen del Verdún llevaba como lema “De la mano de María, discípulos y misioneros de Jesucristo”. Este bello refrán nos recuerda que vamos caminando de la mano de María, nuestra hermana en la fe, para ser como ella, discípulos de su hijo y misioneros del mensaje redentor de Jesucristo. No obstante, hay que reconocer que muchos cristianos, especialmente nosotros, los latinoamericanos, nos quedamos sólo con María y nunca llegamos a Jesús. Eso a María no le gusta ya que toda reverencia a ella debe abrirnos a recibir a su único hijo, Jesús, y adorarlo como nuestro único Señor y salvador.

REFLEXIONEMOS SOBRE LA PALABRA DE DIOS

Al terminar el día los pastores traen a sus ovejas a un mismo redil guiándolas a través de una puerta que había sido custodiada durante la noche. Los pastores le ponían nombre a sus ovejas y las llamaban al amanecer, guiándolas de nuevo al pasto. Ya que las ovejas reconocían la voz de su pastor no se confundían con las ovejas que pertenecían a otros. El que los pastores le dieran nombre a cada una de sus ovejas nos deja clara la diferencia entre un buen pastor y un extraño. El buen pastor se preocupaba no sólo de su rebaño en general, sino de cada oveja en particular. Ellas lo conocían a él y él las conocía a ellas. Las ovejas “nunca siguen a un extraño, sino que huyen de él, porque su voz les resulta desconocida” (Juan 10:5). Existen dos palabras en griego para significar “bueno”: *agathos* y *kalos*. *Agathos* se refiere a la bondad moral, como ser una “buena persona”. *Kalos* quiere decir ser “bueno en” o “para” algo. Ciertamente Jesús es el Buen Pastor en ambos sentidos, pero la palabra que se usa aquí es *kalos*, a fin de enfatizar que él es “bueno para” pastorear. Jesús conoce a sus ovejas por nombre, las dirige hacia un lugar seguro al caer la noche y las regresa al pasto. Él estuvo dispuesto a entregar su vida por ellas. Y lo más consolador es que vino entonces y viene ahora para darnos vida y vida en abundancia. Esta imagen nos desafía a todos los que hemos sido llamados a ser pastores en la Iglesia de hoy a ser buenos pastores y ser buenos para pastorear.

REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD

At the end of the day, shepherds would bring their sheep to a common sheepfold, leading them through a gate that was guarded during the night. Shepherds would give names to their sheep and call to them when daylight came, leading them back out to pasture. Because the sheep recognized the shepherd's voice there was no mix-up with sheep that belonged to others. The idea that shepherds had a name for each of their sheep brings home the difference between a good shepherd and a stranger. The good shepherd was concerned not only for the flock but for each sheep in it. He knew them and they knew him. “They will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers” (John 10:5). There are two words in Greek for “good”—*agathos* and *kalos*. *Agathos* refers to moral goodness, as in being a “good person.” *Kalos* refers to being “good at” something. Certainly Jesus is the Good Shepherd in both senses, but the word used here is *kalos*, emphasizing his being “good at” shepherding. Jesus knows his sheep by name, leads them to safety when darkness falls, and returns them to pasture. He was willing to lay down his life for them. Most comforting of all, he came then and comes now so we might have life and have it more abundantly. This image challenges all who have been called to be shepherds in today's church, to be good shepherds and to be good at shepherding.

Baptism of older children *How do I enroll my child?*

Elementary Registration for 2013/14 year
Grades 1-5 in the Religious Ed Office
M-TH 8-4:00 pm - Closed from 12-1:00 pm
A BAPTISM CERTIFICATE is required for each child being registered.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Family must be registered at Christ the King
- Family must be worshipping at Christ the King at our weekend liturgy
- Past due balances from the previous Religious Education year must be paid prior to registering

When are classes held?

Classes are held on Wednesdays at either 4:00 or 5:45 pm

Fees:

- Religious Education Classes \$80.00 per child.
 - First Holy Communion \$125.00 per child.
 - Full Initiation \$150.00 per child.
- \$25 non-refundable deposit is required to register. Payment plans are available.**

SACRAMENTS

(1st Communion, Baptism)

REQUIREMENTS:

- Same as for Religious Education Registration plus:
- Child is in second grade or above
- Child is enrolled in and attending weekly age-level Religious Education classes on a regular basis
- Unbaptized children must attend one full year of Religious Education first

Our sacrament preparation is a family preparation process that requires the participation of the child and a parent or guardian in monthly sessions.

Attendance at these sessions is mandatory.
